

Number and Place Value

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens and ones).
- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words.
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, including the number line.
- Compare and order numbers up to 100, using < , > and = signs.
- Use place value and number facts to solve problems.

Addition and Subtraction

- Add and subtract numbers using concrete objects and pictorial representations.
- Solve problems including addition and subtraction
- Recall and use addition and subtracting facts to 20.

Maths Basic Skills

- Counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s.
- Counting forwards and backwards to 100.





Animals including Humans

- Find out and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air).
- Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring that grow into adults.
- Describe the importance for humans to exercise, eat the right amounts of food and hygiene.
