Dear Parents and Carers,

This week we have seen the first glimpse of Winter, but that hasn't stopped the majority of pupils being in school on time, ready for their learning.

Treehouse: On Monday, children from The Treehouse visited the Cosy Cafe at Woodridge Gardens. They had a wonderful time, practising their life skills by ordering what they would like at the counter and then paying themselves. A huge thank you to the staff for welcoming our pupils - we cannot wait to go back.

Year Five Young Leaders: On Monday morning, some of our year 5 children were specially selected to take part in Young Sports Leaders training at Farringdon Community Academy. They took part in a range of small activities, delivered by experts, which helped them to develop their leadership, teamwork and communication skills. They all listened and watched each coach's demonstrations carefully before following instructions and trying out each task themselves. We are excited to see the Young Leaders applying their new skills in school soon, supporting the younger children in sports activities and during play at break times and lunch times in the new year.

Year 4 Parents Information Session: On Tuesday 18th, parents/carers of children in Year 4 attended an information meeting regarding the Multiplication Tables Check which will take place later this school year. Year 5: Today, 30 pupils from year 5 spent the day at Durham Cathedral, as they were performing with 7 other schools as part of Durham Outreach. The theme of the 9 songs was related to the seasons, and these ranged from 'Summer Holiday' to 'Walking in the Air'. After rehearsing all morning, they performed a concert to a full appreciative Cathedral audience – if you were lucky to attend, I hope you enjoyed the singing. The pupils were amazing and were a credit to the school.



Geography Awareness Day: Today, children across school celebrated Geography Awareness Day. It was an opportunity for the children to explore the world we live in and appreciate all that is good about our planet. Each year group was given a country to focus on and completed a range of activities linked to that country – from composing fact files to comparing human and physical features - and I saw some amazing map work on my travels through school. It was lovely to see the children so engaged in their work. We will be celebrating other events later in the year linked to our Geography curriculum, so stay tuned for further updates.


