

English

Reading

- Recognising phase 3 sounds.
- Blending and reading phase 3 and phase 4 words.
- Beginning to recognise alternative graphemes for taught sounds.
- Reading some tricky words on sight.
- Reading captions and sentences.
- Re-read books to build fluency and confidence.
- Becoming very familiar with key stories.
- Recognising and joining in with predictable phrases.

Writing

- Composing and writing simple sentences.
- Using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
- Using phonic knowledge to spell words.
- Spelling some common exception (tricky) words e.g. 'was' or 'you'.
- Sequencing sentences to form short narratives.

Maths

Number and Place Value

- Counting, reading and writing numbers to 20.
- Representing numbers with objects and pictorial representations including a number line.
- Using language such as equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.
- One more and one less.
- Add and subtract amounts to 20.
- Solve one-step problems involving addition and subtraction.

Science

Animals including Humans

- Identifying, naming, drawing and label the basic parts of the human body.
- Saying which part of the body is associated with each sense.
- Performing simple tests.
